GENERAL CURRICULUM

AL-QURAN

This program focuses on the ability to read, memorize, translate and understand al-Quran al-Kariem. Students will be divided into small groups, accompanied by a hafidz or hafidzah. During the study period students will read al-Quran with a good and correct standard (Tahsin), translate and understand the interpretation and memorize at least 5 Juz for Junior High School, 5-10 Juz for High School level, apart from 'Ulama, and 20-30 Juz for High School majors 'Ulama.

ISLAMIC FOUNDATION

As the core curriculum of Tazkia, the Islamic Foundation focuses on strengthening aqidah, akhlaq, understanding of jurisprudence and daily worship. Students will be given guidance during classroom forums, general tausiyah, group discussion forum (halaqoh) and practicing daily worship.

NATIONAL CURRICULUM

This curriculum refers to the standard content established by the national education service with the primary objective of developing the intellectual, psychological and psycho-motor skills of the students. The standard SMP-SMA curriculum that is used refers to the standard contents provided by the Office of Education. For the SMA level there are two majors, namely IPA and IPS. In the learning process, teaching materials will be integrated with Islamic concepts and values so that students are more aware of the Majesty of Allah SWT.

INTERNATIONAL (CAMBRIDGE)

In collaboration with Center of Cambridge International Examination (CIE) East Java, Tazkia adopts an international curriculum with the primary objective of having international standard qualifications through Check Point exams for Junior High School students and IGCSE exams for High School level. Confidence and a good mastery of English gives our students the opportunity to continue further education at home or abroad.

LANGUAGES

This language program aims to develop students' ability in Arabic and English through a practical and active language curriculum (environment). Both Junior and Senior High School students are expected to be able to use Arabic and English both in daily interaction and for the purpose of learning and researching information internationally.

INTENSIVE CLASS

To help students' excel their academic ability, the curriculum of special interest in Junior High School is provided. Students are welcome to choose one of several specialized programs. These programs are available in class VIII (eight) in semester one and two. In this specialization program, students are expected to be good at one of the academic abilities they are interested in developing further.

PROJECT BASED LEARNING

As an effort to provide a holistic education it is necessary to develop an educational process that facilitates both Junior and Senior High school students to solve problems using multiple disciplines. Project Based Learning integrates various subjects so that project teams can solve given problems.

ENRICHMENT AND EXTENSION

To nurture confident and insightful individuals, Tazkia provides a variety of activities outside the classroom to improve skills for self-development and recreation.

For self-development programs, students can join various programs such as Tazkia Students Association, The Entrepreneur, Smart Cooking, Scout Leader, Red Crescent, The Scientist and The Journalist. To cultivate students' aesthetic value, Tazkia provides Islamic Calligraphy, House Keeping, Photography and The Designer. As for building global insights and friendship, students can participate in various learning excursions both at home and abroad.

To build awareness of personal, environmental and social health, Tazkia also organizes a variety of social services and sports programs with choices including Swimming, Horse Riding, Archery, Health Care, Climbing, Taekwondo, Futsal and Fundraising for Free Qur'anic Education Program and Scholarship.

SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL



Changes in global conditions provide a challenge for Tazkia to prepare education for upper secondary level, SMA Tazkia IIBS. The Holistic and Personalized concept is carried forward from Junior through to High School level.

The concept of Personalized means that students are given a specialized program according to their work plan which is based on their interests and results from career counselling. The courses offered are different from other schools in general. The aims of this department were identified through research involving various practitioners, ranging from business, professional, ulama, corporate and organizational leaders, academics, and prospective guardian santri. The specialized program develops the ability of students' Mindset, Skillset and Toolset which is honed from an early age in accordance with their field of interest.

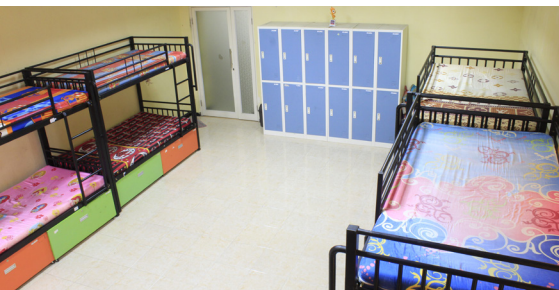

Campus 1 TAZKIA IIBS covers an area of 10,000 m² with a beautiful environment and modern buildings specifically for female students. There are class facilities, science labs, libraries and offices located within the building of Andalusia. The student dormitories are located in the Cambridge building, Al-Azhar and Alexandria which are especially designed to provide comfort for students and murobbiyah activities in which there is also a Medical Center, Astronomy Lab, Hall and a musollah.

CAMPUS 1



TAZKIA IIBS provides dedicated dormitory rooms equipped with adequate spacious accommodation facilities, and allows 6-12 students per room. Supporting facilities also include a gazebo, sports arena and natural lab.



Campus 1 TAZKIA IIBS also provides specially designed classrooms for each faculty: Science Laboratory, Language Faculty, Math & Science Faculty, Social & Leadership Faculty, Islamic Studies Faculty, Islamic Civilization Faculty, and Quran & Hadith Faculty. All equipped with audio visual capability.



To support the learning activities, TAZKIA IIBS provides Integrated Resource Center (IRC) which is a blend of library, internet access, discussion and consultation areas. With internet connection and a host of PCs, IRC provides fast, complete and easy digital access.

CAMPUS 2

Campus 2 TAZKIA IIBS began operating in the academic year 2017-2018 which is dedicated to male students both Junior and Senior High School level. Located on a plateau of more than 20,000 m² with two buildings consisting of four floors. The Al Azhar and Leiden buildings are designed in a modern way that adds to the comfort of students' learning. Campus 2 also provides the greatest landscape view with 2 mountains as the background increasing the students' mood.



Campus 2 TAZKIA IIBS also provides specially designed classrooms for each faculty: Science Laboratory, Language Faculty, Math & Science Faculty, Social & Leadership Faculty, Islamic Studies Faculty, Islamic Civilization Faculty, and Quran & Hadith Faculty. All equipped with audio visual capability.



Tazkia IIBS provides building contains dormitories with a capacity of 6-12 students per room, classrooms, Hall and place of worship. To give the comfortable living of Tazkia Students, Campus 2 is also equipped with laundry services, canteen, and outdoor gazebo.



To support the needs of students in sport, Tazkia provide supporting facilities in the form of a sports center that can be utilized by all students such as basketball arena, table tennis and wall climbing guided directly from the experts.

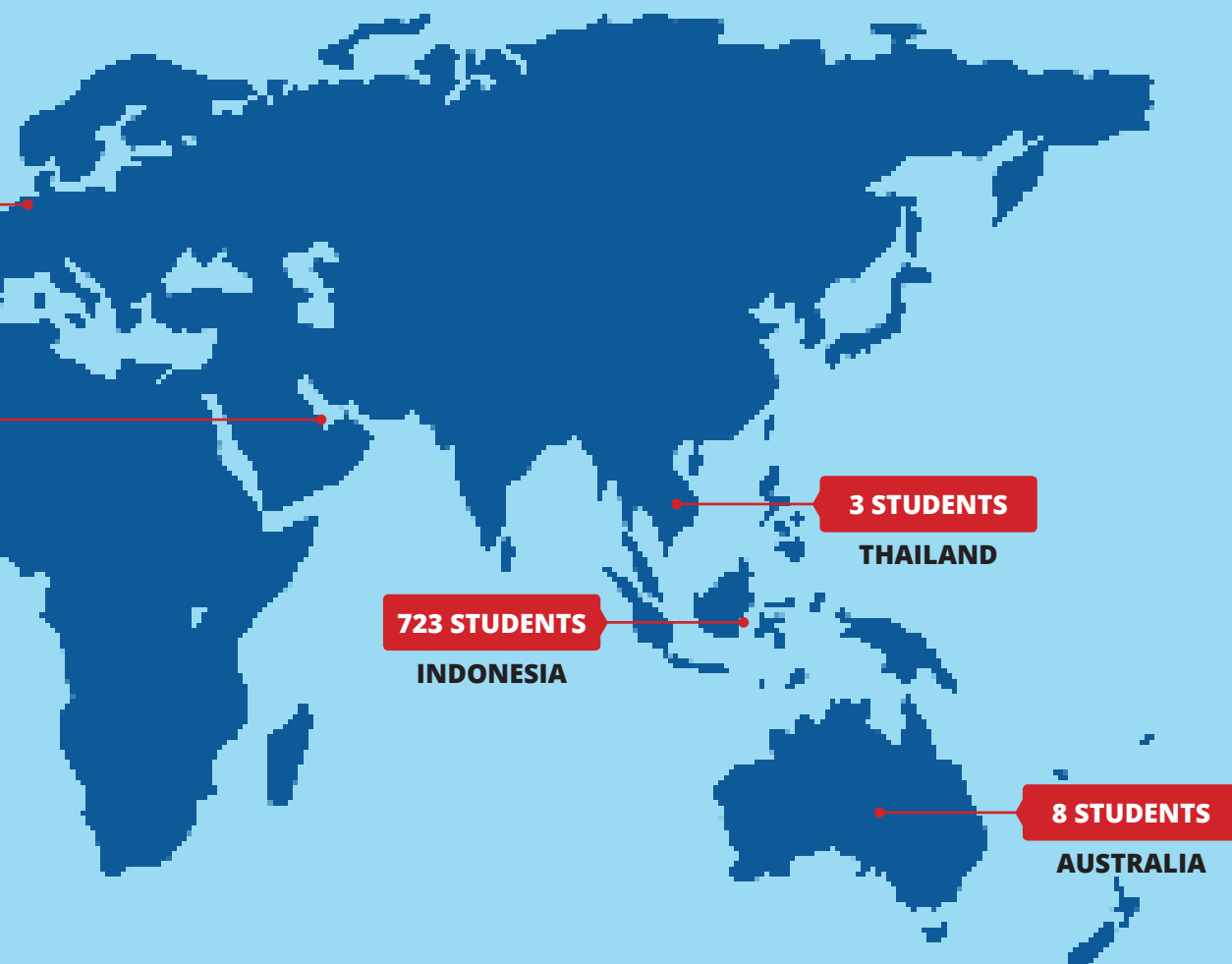

PASS PRIORITY ENROLMENT

Registration in Tazkia IIBS uses a system called the Pass Priority Program, a program specifically designed to recruit

new students from 2nd, 3rd, 4th and 5th grade for Junior and 7th and 8th grade for Junior High or equivalent to High School level. Prospective students who enroll through this program, have a fantastic opportunity to be accepted as a Tazkia student.

For applicants who are accepted as candidates for Junior High school will receive coaching program for both Quran, Arabic and English, academic and counseling. It is expected that when graduated from primary school or equivalent, prospective students are ready to join boarding or boarding based education program in Tazkia IIBS Malang.

- Submit a photocopy of report cards for the last two semesters for junior high school applicants
- Pass tests for the Pass Priority Program: Psychology test, Reading Al-Qur'an, Interview Student's Guardian and Prospective Students, Health and academic tests include Math, Science, English and Arabic specifically for high school applicants
- After being accepted, pay the registration fee according to the student candidate's grade level

Prospective students who have registered as a Tazkia student, will be invited to become a member of Tazkia Group Online Forum used for information center and distance learning for the students.

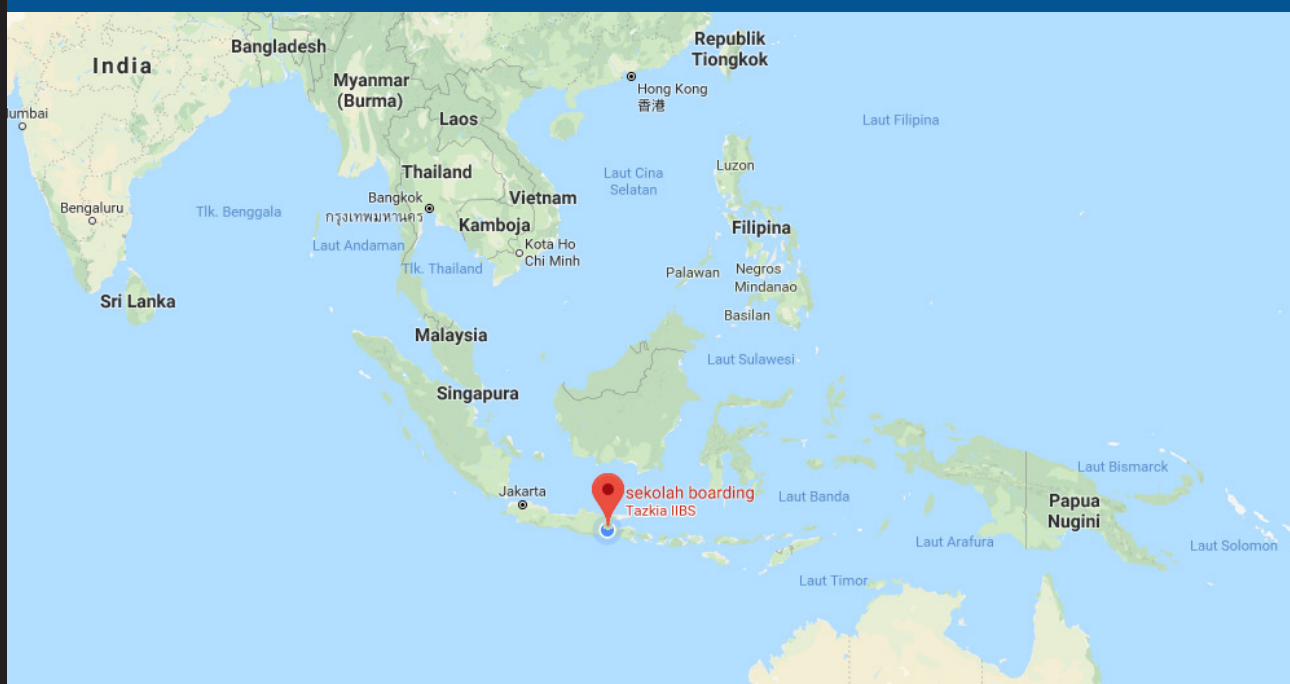
